Business News in New Haven

Sauder Manufacturing Company

Sauder Manufacturing Co., a commercial furniture manufacturer, recently announced plans to invest \$3.2 million to expand its operations into New Haven, creating up to 60 new jobs over the next four years. Established in 1943, Sauder is North America's leading producer of ready-to-assemble furniture and one of the top five residential furniture manufacturers in the United States. Located at 10801 Rose Avenue, the 159,000 square-foot facility will nearly double Sauder's current production and office space. It will also enable the company to improve production work flows, improve access for the logistics needed to serve its customers, and provide capacity for its continued growth, particularly in the healthcare market. The company plans to begin work on the new facility this summer and anticipates completing the relocation in late 2017. The company, which is a subsidiary of Ohio-based Sauder Woodworking Co., serves four markets (worship, healthcare, higher education and human services) with annual sales of \$100 million. The City of New Haven is proud to have Sauder Manufacturing as the newest member of our business community. Their relocation and expansion in northeast Indiana is further proof of the excellent business climate of our state.

Continental Diamond Tool

More jobs are coming to New Haven with the expansion of a metal manufacturing company. Continental Diamond Tool will be constructing a new manufacturing campus on Rose Avenue adjacent to the former Park Hannifin Building. The new building will be approximately 112,000 square feet allowing the company to expand into the future. With a projected total investment of approximately \$12 million, the company will retain approximately 69 employees and add an additional 77 over the next several years. Founded in 1973, Continental Diamond Tool specializes in the design, manufacture and application of diamond and CBN cutting and grinding products and services for a wide range of industries. These include: medical, oil and gas, automotive, aerospace, electronics, as well as many others. CDT has the ability for sales and manufacturing to work together to ensure their customers are satisfied.

Lippert Components Manufacturing

Lippert Components has finalized plans to expand in New Haven. The company will be relocating its existing manufacturing facility located on Nelson Road to the southeast corner of Ryan Road and Edgerton Road. The manufacturing campus will consist of a new 409,150 square feet building on 50 acres. Lippert will invest approximately \$19 million in this expansion. The company will retain its existing workforce of approximately 180 workers and add approximately 140 new positions over the next several years. Lippert Components is a leading supplier of components to the recreational vehicle and residential housing industries, as well as adjacent industries including bus, cargo and equestrian trailer, marine and heavy truck. From 48 facilities throughout the United States, Canada and Italy, Lippert has more than 8,000 employees who work together to bring innovative product solutions to market every day.
