This year's New Haven Citizen's Academy Training Program wrapped up on April 25th. The Mayor's Office created a unique Citizens' Academy program to provide an educational series for all residents. Mayor McMichael began offering this interactive forum for citizens again and will continue to offer once each year. The expanded program offers residents the opportunity to learn about the City of New Haven and how all departments are structured and managed. Through this educational series, residents learn the following:

- Functionality of local government.
- Responsibilities of each department and how each department operates.
- What services and programs are available through city agencies.
- How to access needed services.
- Learn about volunteer opportunities throughout the community.

The purpose of the Citizens' Academy is to engage New Haven citizens with their city government by providing an interactive forum to learn first-hand how the City of New Haven operates; the city's relationship with Allen County and other public agencies; what services and programs are available through city agencies; how to access needed services; and how to apply this knowledge by serving as an information resource for your neighborhoods, non-profit groups and local businesses. The Academy format brings together elected, appointed officials and other community leaders with participants in an informal setting where participants learn through presentations and information sharing.

As a result of residents participating in the Citizens' Academy throughout the years, we have seen residents who have become elected officials, including Mayor McMichael, members of City Council, members appointed to boards and commissions, and residents who have become volunteers for the city.

During this most recent series, Mayor McMichael's Senior Staff provided information on how their departments function. We also hosted special guest speakers that included the Indiana Department of Transportation, N&S Railroad, Fort Wayne Utilities, Allen County Commissioners, NIPSCO, Paulding Putnam, I&M/AEP, the Adams Township Trustee's office, our State Representative Dave Heine, and regional economic development leaders.

As our city continues to grow and attract new families, we find ourselves faced with many challenges. New Haven continues to build for the future and provide the very best for you – our residents.

NEW HAVEN CLERK-TREASURER RECEIVES SPECIAL DESIGNATION

In May, the Indiana League of Municipal Clerk Treasurers (ILMCT) announced that New Haven Clerk-Treasurer Natalie Strock earned the designation of the Indiana Accredited Municipal Clerk (IAMC). This certification is awarded to those municipal clerks who not only complete the demanding education of municipal law, payroll, financial reporting, responsible for serving residents and the maintenance of public documents, just a few of the duties of a municipal Clerk-Treasurer, but who also have a record of significant contributions to their local government, community, and state.

Natalie began her career with the City of New Haven in the New Haven City Court in 2010 where she served as Clerk of Courts for eight (8) years. She then served as Accounts Payable and Payroll Clerk in the Clerk Treasurer's Office in 2018. Natalie was elected to the office of Clerk-Treasurer in 2019 and began serving in that position in 2020.

Natalie studied at Ivy Tech Community College where she received her Technical Certificate in Accounting on courses that include payroll accounting, financial accounting, income tax, accounting systems applications, and managerial accounting.

FIREWORKS REMINDERS

As we prepare to celebrate Independence Day, the City of New Haven would like to remind residents that Indiana state law (I.C. §22-11-14-10.5) regulates the usage of consumer fireworks within the State of Indiana to specific dates and times listed below. Additionally, §91.37 of the Municipal Code states that: (A) No person within the City of New Haven may use, ignite, or discharge or permit to be used, ignited or discharged any type of Consumer Fireworks on any other day or time other than the following:

★ **June 29th, 30th – July 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th**
*(between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to two hours after sunset)

★ **July 4th**
*(between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight)


