Program, Pool, and Rental Refund Policy

Refunds will be processed upon request for pavilion reservations, Community Center rentals, recreation classes, programs, and leagues in accordance with the following policy:

1. Full refunds will be made upon cancellation of a class, activity or rental by the Parks and Recreation Department.
2. Full refunds will be granted to individuals paying with cash if requested at least 10 full business days before the program begins.
3. Full refunds less a processing and handling fee of \$5 or 10% (whichever is greater) will be granted to individuals paying by credit card if requested at least 10 full business days before the program begins.
4. Refunds requested less than ten business days prior to the beginning of a program or activity may be granted only for illness or medical reasons. Any refunds will be subject to being prorated in the form of user credit to your account with us, which may then be applied to a future purchase. Requests for refunds may only be made by phone or in person.
5. No refunds or transfers after the beginning date of a program for any other reason than what is listed above.
6. Refunds for cancelled Pavilion/Community Center reservations shall be granted as follows:
 - 31 or more days' notice – Full Refund
 - 30 days to 2 weeks' notice – Refund 10% of the total rental amount. Transfers are allowed if dates are available.
 - Less than 2 weeks' notice – No Refunds/No Transfers.
7. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks for processing refunds.



New Haven Parks & Recreation Rules, Regulations & Code of Conduct In order to facilitate a positive experience for all participants and visitors, New Haven-Adams Twp. Parks and Recreation Department has a code of conduct that includes expectations, rules, and procedures for anyone who participates in one of our programs or visits our parks and facilities. We reserve the right to refuse service or remove anyone who is not in line with the following:

1. Refrain from the use of foul language.
2. Inappropriate and threatening behavior will not be tolerated.
3. Do not use equipment or facilities in a manner other than which it was intended.
4. Any clothing with logos or messages must be acceptable in a family setting.
5. Do not move or re-arrange any park equipment or property.
6. Alcohol is not permitted on Park Property without the proper permits.
7. Smoking and/or use of any type of smokeless tobacco is prohibited inside any facility.
8. Drugs are prohibited.
9. Hunting or use of firearms of any kind prohibited on park grounds and inside any facility.
10. Littering is prohibited.
11. Motorized vehicles are prohibited off roadways and beyond parking areas.
12. No overnight parking permitted.
13. Vending or sales prohibited without permit.
14. Dogs are to remain on leash at all times.
15. Pet owners are required to pick up after pets.
16. Plants and animals are protected - do not remove or mistreat.
17. Control noise levels -please be respectful of others.
18. No person may deposit refuse from private premises in trash receptacles.
19. No person may possess and or discharge any fireworks or other explosive pyrotechnics on park property, except by special permit.
20. No person may engage in gaming or gambling for money or any other thing in any form on Park property

This is not an inclusive list. Common courtesy, additional rules and regulations may apply, as well as, common sense!

Please note: Facility rental fees are subject to change

Community Center Rentals

- Hourly Rate (2 hour minimum)
- Community Center rentals require a 50% deposit at the time the reservation is made. The balance is due 2 weeks before the scheduled rental.
- If extra set-up/tear down time is needed you must add time to your rental.
- All spaces may not be available due to NHPD Programming.
- 7% Sales tax will be added to all rentals
- A \$50 Utility/Maintenance fee will be added to each rental.

Deetz Nature Preserve

Deetz Nature Preserve, named after retired maintenance director, Thomas Deetz, became park property in 2006. Located at the intersection of Parrot and Hartzell Roads, Deetz Nature Preserve is 72 acres of low-lying wetland area. The preserve-now a beautiful, natural area-was donated by Waste Management. The area has been replanted with native grasses, and the reforestation process has been started with the planting of many young trees. The area has multiple mowed trails, a parking area, and an outdoor classroom. The area is a fantastic location for leisure walks, bird watching, and nature hiking.

Haskamp woods can be accessed through Pinestone Association on Seiler Road with street parking only. The natural trail is approximately .7mile.

Moser Park Nature Trails

A quarter mile handicapped accessible trail runs through Moser Park woods. Natural trails also criss-cross this woods and is home to New Haven Parks and Recreation Disc golf course.

The New Haven trailhead for the Rivergreenway begins with the Moser Park trail. The Rivergreenway is a great place for biking, running, jogging, walking, rollerblading, and enjoying natural space. The trail runs along the Maumee River bank in New Haven and eventually along the St. Marys and St. Joseph rivers in Fort Wayne. The entire Rivergreenway is a 40-mile trail. Visitors may track the total distance they have traveled because the Rivergreenway mile markers are located along the trail. New Haven cares for a three-mile portion of the Rivergreenway, a National Recreation Trail.
